ORDINANCE NO. 3-9-17

TO AMEND SECTIONS 10.03 AND 10.04 OF THE TOWN OF WEST POINT CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING SPEED LIMITS ON CERTAIN TOWN ROADS.

THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF WEST POINT, COLUMBIA COUNTY, WISCONSIN HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the Town Board received a Petition from the Selwood Farm Properties Owners Association, Inc. requesting that the existing 35 miles per hour ("mph") speed limit for Selwood Road, West Point Drive, Crestwood Drive and Reichman Road be reduced to 25 mph; and

WHEREAS, for public safety considerations, the Town Board believes it to be in the best interest of the Town to lower the speed limit to 25 mph on the requested town roads; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority of Section 349.11(3)(c), Wis. Stats., the Town Board may reduce the existing 35 mph speed limit by ten (10) mph without Wisconsin Department of Transportation approval;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of West Point, Columbia County, Wisconsin does hereby ordain as follows:

- 1. Section 10.3 of the Town of West Point Code of Ordinances is amended as follows: delete Selwood Road, West Point Drive, Crestwood Drive and Riechman Road from the list of roads subject to the 35 mph speed limit.
- 2. Section 10.04 of the Town of West Point Code of Ordinances is amended as follows: add Selwood Road, West Point Drive, Crestwood Drive and Riechman Road to the roads subject to the 25 mph speed limit.
- 3. Pursuant to Section 349.11(5), Wis. Stats., the town chair, or the chair's designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the designated roads conforming to the rules of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation and, upon such placement, enforcement of the new speed limits shall take effect.
- 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided by law with enforcement to commence upon placement of appropriate signage.
