

## TOWN OF WEST POINT

Pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 19.84, the town board of the Town of West Point held a special town board meeting on Friday, October 23, 2015 at 7:00 p.m. at the West Point Town Hall. The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise, the Sauk Prairie Star, posted in the three designated places in the town and on the town's web site.

The town board meeting was called to order by Dean Schwarz-Town Chairman at 7:10 p.m. The town board members present were: Dean Schwarz-Town Chairman, John Miller-1<sup>st</sup> Supervisor, Gordon Carncross-2<sup>nd</sup> Supervisor, Ashley Nedeau-Owen-3<sup>rd</sup> Supervisor, and Matt Zeman - 4<sup>th</sup> Supervisor. Also present was Taffy Buchanan-Town Clerk.

The Town Board worked on the 2016 budget for West Point. A motion was made by Dean Schwarz to approve the 2016 budget they worked on to be presented to the public with a reduction in the unrestricted cash balance to 25% of the total expenses unless the Towns Association says it should be lower and to put that money into Highway Reconstruction, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Matt Zeman – motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by John Miller to adjourn the October 23, 2015 special town board meeting at 8:50 p.m., 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ashley Nedeau-Owen – motion carried unanimously.
