

## TOWN OF WEST POINT

A public hearing for the 2021 Town of West Point Budget was held on Thursday, November 11, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. at the Town Hall. The public hearing was published in the Star News and the Enterprise, posted in three places and on the Town's web site.

The public hearing was opened at 6:30 p.m.

A copy of the summary of the proposed budget was also posted in three places. There were 9 residents present.

Copies of the 2022 proposed budget were available to residents. Residents asked questions about the proposed budget. Gordon Carncross asked why there was a large increase in Public Safety for 2022. Ashley stated it was because the Sauk Fire District is purchasing a ladder truck and the Town of West Point's portion is \$164,287.38.

The Public Hearing was closed at 6:37 p.m.
