RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Transfer Site for use by West Point residents and property owners only.
2. All users are required to have a Transfer Site Permit. The permit must be placed on the driver side dash and visible for inspection by Transfer Site employees.

3. All Recyclable materials shall be deposited into proper containers. All trash in clear bags!
4. Cash and checks made out to the Town of West Point. Debit and credit cards CAN NOT be accepted at this time.

TRASH – *Normal household waste – empty of all recyclables. Bagged in clear plastic garbage bags.*

CO-MINGLED RECYCLABLES

- **ALUMINUM** – *All types - clean, empty, cans crushed or not.*
- **TIN CANS** – *Food cans ONLY – clean and dry.*
- **PLASTIC** – *Bottles/Jars ONLY – clean, remove caps. Plastic grocery/shopping bags are not currently recyclable.*
- **GLASS** – *Bottles/Jars ONLY – clean, remove caps.*
- **PAPER** – *Newspaper, Magazines, Office Paper, Junk Mail – clean and dry ONLY. No Beer or Soda boxes.*

CARDBOARD – *Corrugated Non-Wax any type - clean, flattened. Remove any wax or plastic liners.*

BATTERIES -*All types, Car, Radio, Flashlight, etc.*

SCRAP METAL – Iron & Tin, any metal – Nails, Pipe, Cast & Sheet Metal, Rods, Stoves, Dishwashers, Washers, and Dryers.

FLUORESCENT BULBS –

Small Fluorescent & 4-ft. Fluorescent – 1.00 each

8-foot Fluorescent - 2.00 each

Ballast - \$5.00 each

ELECTRONICS –

Desk Top Computer (CPU), Printer (ink jet), Scanner, Fax Machine, VCR/Receiver, Typewriter, Microwave - \$10.00 each

Lap Top Computer, Printer (laser,)

Printer (larger free standing), Computer Monitor, Plotter - \$15.00 each

Television - \$20.00 each

Copy Machine (business) - \$40.00 each

NOT ACCEPTED - Refrigerators, Freezers, Air Conditioners, and Dehumidifiers. We suggest you work with the supplier of your new appliance regarding disposal of your old appliance or you can take it to the Columbia County Recycling & Waste Site at W7465 Highway 16, Pardeeville, WI.

NOT ACCEPTED – Hazardous materials, Medical Waste, Pesticides, Herbicides, Liquid Paint, Used Motor Oil, Old Gasoline, Tires, Brake Fluid, Anti-Freeze, Explosives and Driveway Sealer.

NON-RECYCLABLE –*Mirrors, Clay Pots, Ceramics, Window Glass, Dishes, Rubber Hoses, Furnace Filters, Waxed Cardboard, and Plastic Toys.*

Place in construction dumpster.

CONSTRUCTION DUMPSTERS ARE AVAILABLE IN THE MONTHS OF MAY AND SEPTEMBER ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS – *Shingles, plaster, drywall, carpet, pad, wall tile, toilets, furniture, insulation, mattresses, sinks, box springs and other non-recyclables will be taken at that time.*

TREE LIMBS AND BRUSH WILL BE ACCEPTED AND BURNED ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS.

GRASS CLIPPINGS, LEAVES, AND PINE NEEDLES ARE NOT TO BE DEPOSITED IN THE BURN PILE. THEY SHOULD BE PLACED IN THE DESIGNATED COMPOST PILE.

CLEAN AG & SILAGE PLASTIC SHOULD BE PLACED IN THE DESIGNATED DUMPSTER. THE DUMPSTER IS AVAILABLE YEAR-ROUND.
