Amendments to Chapters 3, 6, 8 and 12 of the West Point Code of Ordinances

The Town Board of the Town of West Point, Columbia County, will hold a public hearing on October 13, 2022, at 7:00 p.m., at the West Point Town Hall, N2144 Rausch Road, Lodi, Wisconsin. The purpose of the public hearing is to allow all interested parties to be heard, concerning proposed amendments to the Town's Ordinances that have been recommended by the Town's Plan Commission. The sections recommended for amending are noted below.

Chapter 3 of the Town's Code of Ordinances is entitled **Boards and Committees.** The recommended amendments to that Chapter cover Sections 3.12, 3.20, 3.21, 3.22, 3.23, 3.31 and 3.38(D) of that Chapter.

Chapter 6 of the Town's Code of Ordinances is entitled Land Division, Siting Criteria and Transfer of Residential Development Rights and Regulations. The proposed amendments to that Chapter cover Sections 6.04(A)(2)(D), 6.12(B) - (D), and 6.20(A)(1) of that Chapter.

Chapter 8 of the Town's Code of Ordinances is entitled **Building Code.** The proposed amendments to that Chapter cover Sections 8.04, 8.05, 8.07, 8.11 and 8.12 of that Chapter.

Chapter 12 of the Town's Code of Ordinances is entitled **Roads and Construction and Maintenance of Driveways.** The recommended amendments comprehensively amend and restate the provisions of that Chapter.
