RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Transfer Site for use by West Point residents and property owners only.
- **2.** All users are required to have a Transfer Site Permit. The permit must be placed on the driver side dash and visible for inspection by Transfer Site employees.

- **3.** All Recyclable materials shall be deposited into proper containers.
- **4.** All trash in clear bags!
- 5. Cash and checks made out to the Town of West Point.

 Debit and credit cards CAN NOT be accepted at this time.

<u>TRASH DUMPSTERS</u> – Normal household waste – empty of all recyclables. Bagged in clear plastic garbage bags.

CO-MINGLED RECYCLABLES DUMPSTERS

- <u>ALUMINUM</u> All types clean, empty, cans crushed or not.
- <u>TIN CANS</u> Food cans ONLY *clean and dry*.
- <u>PLASTIC</u> Bottles/Jars ONLY clean, remove caps. Plastic grocery/shopping bags are not currently recyclable.
- <u>GLASS</u> *Bottles/Jars ONLY clean, remove caps.*
- PAPER Newspaper, Magazines, Office Paper, Junk Mail – clean and dry ONLY. No Beer or Soda boxes.

<u>CARDBOARD DUMPSTERS</u> – Corrugated Non-Wax any type - clean, flattened. Remove any wax or plastic liners.

<u>SCRAP METAL DUMPSTER</u> – Iron & Tin, any metal – Nails, Pipe, Cast & Sheet Metal, Rods, Stoves, Dishwashers, Washers, and Dryers.

<u>BURN PILE</u> – Tree limbs and brush will be accepted and burned on a first come first serve basis. NO grass, leaves or pine needles!

<u>COMPOST PILE</u> – *Grass clippings, leaves and pine needles. NO woody brush!*

<u>AGRICULTURAL PLASTIC DUMPSTER</u> – Clean Ag Bag and Silage plastic ONLY.

SEASONAL "CONTRUCTION" DUMPSTERS

- May and September ONLY - First Come First Serve - Shingles, plaster, drywall, carpet, pad, wall tile, toilets, furniture, insulation, mattresses, sinks, box springs, mirrors, clay pots, ceramics, window glass, dishes, rubber hoses, furnace filters, waxed cardboard, plastic toys and any other non-recyclables will be taken at that time.

(residential use only not for business use)

NOT ACCEPTED ITEMS

Hazardous materials, Medical Waste, Pesticides, Herbicides, Liquid Paint, Used Motor Oil, Old Gasoline, Tires, Brake Fluid, Anti-Freeze, Explosives and Driveway Sealer.

Refrigerators, Freezers, Air Conditioners, and Dehumidifiers. We suggest you work with the supplier of your new appliance regarding disposal of your old appliance or you can take it to the Columbia County Recycling & Waste Site at W7465 Highway 16, Pardeeville, WI.
